



**Call for admission to the Bachelor's Degree in
Comparative, European and International Legal Studies
academic year 2018/19 – Spring session**

The University of Trento, Faculty of Law, announces a public procedure for the admission of EU students to the first year of the Bachelor's Degree in *Comparative, European and International Legal Studies* (academic year 2018-2019) based on candidates' qualifications and interview. Access is restricted to **30 places**. The admission test will take place **on 13 April 2018 at 3.00 p.m.** and will be held in English, in accordance with the official language of the course.

Admission requirements

Admission to the test is open to Italian citizens, EU-citizens, and non-EU citizens with a valid Italian residence permit (according to article 26 of Act No. 189/2002) holding:

- an Italian high school diploma, or
- a foreign high school diploma recognized as valid for the enrolment to a bachelor's course in Italy.

Candidates who are still attending the last year of secondary school are also admitted, subject to the condition of obtaining their diploma in the year 2017/18.

Candidates shall certify their knowledge of English. At least a B2 level is required in accordance with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. Candidates shall certify their knowledge with:

- international certificate e.g. IELTS, TOEFL, CAE or similar
- provisional Statement of Result, proving that the language exam has been successfully passed

Certification is not required for candidates declaring that:

- have been awarded a Diploma entirely taught in English
- have English as their mother tongue
- reside for a substantial period in a Country where English is an official language.

The language requirement will be verified once the candidates are enrolled. In the case the requirement is missing, students will have to recover it by the first exam session.

Online application

The online application procedure will be open **from 6 February until 26 March 2018, at noon**- at the following link <http://www.unitn.it/ammissioni2018>.

In order to apply for the admission test, candidates must first create a UniTrento account by following the above link. They are expected to complete this operation at least 3 days **before the 26 March** in order to allow sufficient time for any possible technical support as provided via email (please write to ammissioni@unitn.it).

All data must be carefully completed.

In the application process candidates will opt for one of the locations of the admission test (see below).

Admission test

The exam, of the duration of 80 minutes, consists of 80 multiple-choice questions divided into two areas:

- a. 70 questions assessing general culture from an international perspective
- b. 10 questions assessing basic IT skills

The same **admission test will take place at 3.00 p.m.** in the following locations:

- TRENTO – University of Trento – Department of Humanities, Via Tommaso Gar, 14
- BARI – Liceo Classico Statale “Q. Orazio Flacco”, Via Pizzoli 58
- MANTOVA - Liceo Artistico “Giulio Romano” via Trieste, 48
- PALERMO – Liceo Classico Statale “Vittorio Emanuele II”, via Simone di Bologna, 11;
- ROME – Auditorium Antonianum, viale Manzoni 1
- BRUXELLES – “No Peace without Justice”, Rue Ducale 41, Bruxelles 1000

The **identification procedure will start at 2.30 p.m.** in all locations except for Trento, where the identification procedure will begin at **2.00 p.m.**.

Candidates are expected to arrive on time and to show an identity document, alongside with a valid Italian residence permit if they are non EU citizens.
